



## Vineyard Selection

## HAWKE'S BAY MERLOT 2019

VINEYARD REGION	Hawke's Bay Predominantly from Bridge Pa wine sub-region.
VINTAGE CONDITIONS	2019 will go down as one of the great Hawke's Bay vintages. Moderate flowering and fruit set in November and December set up the vines for moderate yields which in turn means high quality fruit with intense flavour. Superb weather in early 2019 lasted ensuring harvesting of small, concentrated berries with superb flavour.
WINEMAKING	After selective harvesting fruit was immediately taken to the winery where it was gently pressed. A short cold soak was undertaken to build mouthfeel and colour, followed by a hot ferment to maximise flavour. Following fermentation the wine was left to rest and mature in used French oak for six months.
NOSE	Juicy damson plum, bright red currant, alluring mocha spice and a hint of vanilla.
PALATE	From its enticing fragrance, this Merlot delivers soft, elegant fruit intensity. The purity of its ripe fruit is enhanced by soft tannin.

FOOD MATCH: This Merlot is perfect to enjoy with an easy beef burger dinner, or for a serious evening serve it alongside
