VINEYARD REGION | MARLBOROUGH, NELSON, WAIPARA AND HAWKE'S BAY

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

Vintage 2019 was a winner in every region across New Zealand and this Pinot Gris is richer for it. Warm, dry conditions in Marlborough produced Pinot Gris with generous aromatics, concentrated favour and texture. Nelson also enjoyed a warm, dry growing season providing fruit with ripe flavours and great concentration. Further south, Waipara had a great vintage growing wonderfully aromatic Pinot Gris with aromas of white rose and honeysuckle. 2019 was the best vintage in Hawkes Bay for several years, warm and dry growing conditions yielding concentrated flavours and textural Pinot Gris.

WINEMAKING

Each parcel of Pinot Gris is harvested at optimum ripeness. Short skin contact adds flavour and texture to the wine. Fermented in stainless steel tanks, we used very select aromatic yeasts to make the wine more intense. We stopped the ferment early to retain a small amount of acidity and natural sugar to give the wine it's off-dryness. The wine was held on lees for two months to help build mouth feel & texture, then blended and bottled.
