How I'm Grown

Hawke's Bay faced challenges during the 2022/3 growing season, with initially warm conditions followed by settled weather during the crucial flowering and fruit set period, the region then experienced the effects of La Niña weather cycles, culminating in Tropical Cyclone Gabrielle mid-February. Our focus quickly shifted to supporting our grower partners in the region, and we identified quality blocks of fruit that were optimal for harvesting. Merlot showcases ripe, soft tannins and the classic red fruit flavours of Hawke's Bay.

How I'm Made

Fully ripe Merlot grapes were harvested at optimal ripeness, then fermented on skins for 7 days to give a rich, dark coloured classic New Zealand Merlot. After aging on French and American oak for 6 months, the wine was delicately dealcoholized using spinning cone at our Marlborough winery. The resultant wine shows the fullness and body of a classic NZ Merlot, with ripe flavour and great structure, yet with only half the alcohol content, and less than half the calories.
